I have a fantastic example of selfless teamwork that I want to share with all of you, as well as publicly thank both James Shewey and Mike Gray for going way out of the norm to help our the consulting team this month.

For larger NHAs, it is not uncommon for us to assemble a team of specialist resources to assist with the data collection, writing and presentation.
